- Experience in planning and delivering software platforms used across multiple products and organizational units
- Web site usage analytics for prescribed behaviors such as but not limited to Google Analytics
- Capable of researching and integrating third-party systems such as but not limited to eCommerce and recruiting solutions with new and existing applications
- Knowledge of popular CMS frameworks is an asset (WordPress)
- Knowledge of popular full stack development frameworks (LAMP or MEAN)
- Experience integrating delivering various forms of digital media (video, webcast, images, product information)
